

TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT PLEASANT

ORDINANCE NO. 20-1985

An ordinance of the Township of Mount Pleasant, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, designating the Mount Pleasant Township Community Center as a public recreation area and delegating the authority to the Mount Pleasant Recreation Board to equip, supervise and maintain the said recreation area.

BE IT ENACTED OR ORDAINED by the supervisors of the Township of Mount Pleasant, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of same as follows:

SECTION I: The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Mount Pleasant, Columbia County, does hereby designate the Mount Pleasant Township Community Center as a public recreation area and authorizes the Mount Pleasant Recreation Board to equip, supervise and maintain in the said recreation area and prepare and submit to the Mount Pleasant Township Supervisors reasonable rules and regulations for the conduct of behavior in said recreation area. (Definition of Maintain "The keeping of the building clean and in Orderly Fashion")

SECTION II: The Mount Pleasant Township Recreation Board shall hereafter from time to time as the said board shall deem necessary prepare and submit to the Mount Pleasant Township Supervisors proposed modifications and/or amendments to the rules and regulations for the conduct of activity in the said recreation area known as the Mount Pleasant Township Community Center.

SECTION III: Upon enactment of the aforesaid rules and regulations together with any amendments and/or modifications as may from time to time be made, the Mount Pleasant Township Recreation Board and the Mount Pleasant Township Police Department or Constable shall have the authority hereunder to enforce and prosecute violations of the said rules and regulations, as amended and/or modified, enacted and ordained by the Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township, Columbia County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION IV: The Mount Pleasant Township Recreation Board shall consist of Five (5) persons. The members shall be appointed by the Mount Pleasant Township Supervisors and shall serve full terms of Three (3) years or until their successors are appointed, except that the members of such board first appointed shall be appointed for such terms that the term of not more than two members shall expire annually thereafter. Members of such board shall serve without pay. All persons appointed shall serve their full terms unless voluntarily resigned or removed by the Supervisors for dereliction or neglect of duty. Vacancies in such board occurring otherwise then by expiration of term shall be for the unexpired term.

SECTION V: The members of the Recreation Board established hereunder shall elect their own chairman and secretary and select all other necessary officers, to serve for a period of one year. The said Recreation Board shall have power to adopt rules and regulations for the conduct of all business within its jurisdiction. Its jurisdiction shall include the right to select, employ and discharge all recreation personnel used to carry out the provisions of this ordinance. In addition, it shall be the duty of the Recreation Board to carry out the provisions of the Act of Assembly, May 1, 1933, P.L. 103, as amended.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest possible date following its enactment.

ORDAINED, PASSED AND ENACTED as an ordinance of the Township of Mount Pleasant, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, at a regular meeting of the Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the 1st day of July, 1985.
