

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT PLEASANT.  
COUNTY OF COLUMBIA AND STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA  
ORDINANCE NO. 1989- 30

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS OF TWENTY-FIVE (25) MILES PER HOUR ALONG CERTAIN PORTIONS OF TOWNSHIP ROAD T-539 (CRAWFORD ROAD), T-504 (STONEY ROAD) AND T-539 (SHANER ROAD).

The following is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, and the same is hereby enacted by authority of same:

**MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS**

Maximum Speed Limits are hereby established on portions of specified roads, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle, on any part of a road where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the road:

<u>ROAD</u>	<u>BETWEEN</u>	<u>MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT</u>
1. T-539 (Crawford Road)	S.R. 4011 AND T-519 (Melick Hollow Road)	25 M.P.H.
2. T-504 (Stoney Road)	S.R. 4013 AND S.R. 4008	25 M.P.H.
3. T-539 (Shaner Road)	S.R. 4011 AND L.R. 19030	25 M.P.H.
