MINUTES

Minutes were presented for December 2010 meeting. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Wagner. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Reports were reviewed. Additional invoice from Northeast Tree Service for \$1500 to trim trees on hedgerow. Resident Bowman will reimburse Township for one half of the total. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Wagner. Motion carried.

Zoning Officer

During the months of November and December I issued five (5) permits. Three were for accessory structures, one for an addition and one for a new home. I've taken several calls regarding the newly enacted law pertaining to sprinkler systems in new home construction. I was under the impression that the law was going to be repealed, but current news reports indicate otherwise. I haven't read the law, and I am referring questions to the building and codes office at Tri-County Inspection Service. As always, I continue to take calls, perform inspections, field monitoring, and follow up on inquiries and complaints.
