

Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of January 3, 2012

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Wagner called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, Gordner; Zoning Officer Sanders and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for December 2011 meeting. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Reports were reviewed. Additional check to Fruit's Fuel Service for \$752.75 approved. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman

- Approximately 22 man hours on maintenance of roads including tree down on Kindt Road.

Old Business

Two quotes were received for a generator. Prices were submitted for a Generac unit and a Kohler unit. Rhone quote Generac \$6247 & Kohler \$7021; Ron Hunter quote Generac \$6540 & Kohler \$7583. There was much discussion by residents about the need for a new generator. However, it was pointed out that the Community Center is emergency headquarters and must have running water, heat and electricity. Supervisor Wagner made motion to accept Rhone Generac quote, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Gordner opposed. Motion carried.

New Business

The PSATS Convention will be in Hershey in May. Supervisor Gordner made motion for Supervisor Wagner to attend, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

For the Township Good

Resident Turner suggested Supervisors inspect roads in April and October as the State once mandated. State no longer requires. However, Turner felt this should be done. Supervisors concurred. Kindt questioned when the Township shed was built and Turner tracked down the information. It was built in 1979. Resident Kressler questioned what happened to the addition that was proposed for the shed. Supervisor Gordner stated that it was tabled partially because of cost. Resident Strausser thanked

Supervisors for the repairs on Mordansville Road. Supervisor Wagner stated the new truck is to be delivered this week. Completion and delivery has been delayed since October. Resident Black stated repairs to Evert Road should be priority due to the volume of traffic.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Fenstermacher, seconded by Supervisor Gordner to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8pm.
