

Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of October 3, 2011

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Wagner called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, and Hock; and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for September 2011 meeting. Supervisor Hock made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Reports were reviewed. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Hock. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman

- Approximately 170 man hours on maintenance of roads including cold patching pot holes, filling pot holes, mowing shoulders, cleaning up trees and limbs, cleaning ditches and pipes from storms, rip-rap, etc.
- 1064 tons of rip-rap placed on Lick Run, Rhodomoyer, Fox Hollow.
- 240 tones of shale.
- 270 tons assorted rip rap, sub base, stock piled.
- Shale on Fester Road.
- Pipes replaced on Robbins, McWilliams, Thomas and Fox Hollow. Stream cleaned on Fox Hollow. Crawford did pipe replacement on Robbins, McWilliams and Thomas.
- Approx 12 man hours shop and maintenance work.
- Approx 13 hours in office.
- Resident Robbins stated water not going thru pipe on Robbins.

Zoning Officer – Not in attendance.

Community Center

Furnace needs to be repaired. Water heater for bathrooms not installed.

Secretary

- Gave update on FEMA/PEMA. Disaster has not been declared as of this date.
- \$16,395.79 in Firemen's Relief Fund monies received and distributed to fire companies. Last year \$10,384.16 was received and distributed.

Correspondence

Liquid Fuels for 2011 will total approximately \$109,511.13. This is increase from \$105,717.68 in 2010.

Old Business

Final versions of pending ordinances have not been received from Jerry Walls.

New Business

- Two families (Hoffa & Stenglein) have requested to be bought out by FEMA. Supervisor Wagner talked to another family (Parks) who wished to elevate his dwelling and remain where he is.
- Township has spent approximately \$53,000 to date for storm damage. Estimated overall costs were \$62,740

Resident Shaffer registered personal complaint. Supervisor Wagner told resident Morrison that rock would be placed on Morrison Road this week. Repair hole in road.

Brief discussion about timing of road repairs at Charmund Road and Back Branch Road. Back Branch should be repaired by November 2011.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Fenstermacher, seconded by Supervisor Hock to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:25pm.
