The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Wagner called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher; Shaffer; Wagner; and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Road Foreman
