-Motion to adopt Emergency Operations Plan Resolution 58-11 made by Supervisor Wagner, seconded by Supervisor Hock. Motion carried.

-Motion to adopt Small Scale Windmills Ordinance 47-11 made by Supervisor Hock, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

--Motion to adopt Large Scale Windmills Ordinance 48-11 made by Supervisor Wagner, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

--After many questions from residents and extensive discussion by Supervisor Wagner, a motion to adopt Burning/Outdoor Furnace Ordinance 49-11 was made by Supervisor Wagner, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried. Residents were urged to recycle. The Township has an agreement with Orange Township for residents to take recycling to bins located at their Township building. Heaps also takes recycling and neither requires it to be sorted. Resident Black stated the County has an ordinance against burning at night.

-Residents were asked to submit to Secretary a letter of interest for the open Auditors positions.
