Supervisor Wagner met with NRCS and Agricultural Department to discuss stream bank erosion. Several properties were inspected.

FEMA Buyout will be split 75% Federal, 22% State and 3% from either Township or property owner.

For the Township Good

-Supervisor Gordner stated the well drillers are requesting permission from the regulatory commissions to spread frack water on farm fields.

-Supervisor Wagner received a request for Township help in cleaning out streams. United Water is sending 100 employees to assist. Supervisors will wait until work is scheduled near Kocher Park which is in Mount Pleasant Township.
