## Minutes of March 7, 2011

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Wagner called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, and Hock; Zoning Officer Sanders and Secretary Kindt.

### MINUTES

Minutes were presented for February 7, 2011 meeting. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Hock. Motion carried.

### FINANCIAL REPORT

Reports were reviewed. Additional invoice for approval: Millville Firemen's Workers Comp (Mt Pleasant portion) \$468.84. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Hock. Motion carried.

#### Road Foreman

Supervisor Wagner made motion, seconded by Supervisor Hock to replace damaged stove. Motion carried.

#### Public Comment

Resident Gordner suggested plowing roads more thoroughly to avoid road deterioration.

#### Correspondence

-Township received request from Orangeville Little League to use ball fields. Supervisor Wagner made motion to approve seconded by Supervisor Hock. Motion carried.

#### New Business

-Sadie Rose Smith sewage module was reviewed. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Hock. Motion carried.

-Resolution 53-11 Paperwork received from State requesting the Township sponsor repairs to Fishing Creek on Back Branch Road. Agreement states the Township would be responsible for any future upkeep or repairs. Decision was tabled until Supervisor Wagner can check details further.
