

Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of April 2, 2012

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Wagner called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, and Gordner; and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for March 2012 meeting. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. \$1990 refund received following Workers Comp audit. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman

-110 hours road maintenance including grading, rolling, placing sub-base on Crouse, Feaster, Lamoreaux and part of Lick Run.

-36 hours on maintenance of equipment.

-6 hours with FEMA going over flood work.

-2 hours office work.

-4 hours meeting with County about EWP money.

Seal coat on Evert, Turner High View, and Mellick; base repair and widening of Mordansville all being left for bid through the COG. Approximate cost \$120,000.

Zoning Officer

Not in attendance.

Community Center

Supervisor Fenstermacher checked on replacement windows for the Community Center. \$225 each. He will get additional quotes for same type windows for comparison. Supervisors will hire someone to install. Supervisor Gordner suggested contacting Larry's Lumber to check condition of windows in place now.

Secretary

Nothing to report.

Correspondence

PPL sent letter informing Township that no obstructions (i.e. pools, sheds, etc) can be placed in PPL's right of way for power lines.

Old Business

-\$500 donation received from VFW. Letter sent to American Legion requesting similar donation.

-Emergency monies received by Columbia County for stream repair on nine properties in Mount Pleasant. FEMA paying 75% of cost; County 12 ½%. Township being asked to pay 12 ½%. FEMA requested Township sign an agreement. Supervisor Wagner stated there is no obligation even if agreement is signed. FEMA will provide design. Work must be completed by August 2012. Supervisor Fenstermacher felt taxpayers monies should not be used. He felt residents should sign agreement to pay a portion of the balance needed. Supervisor Wagner made motion to sign agreement, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

-Resident Hock questioned what the policy was for working supervisors. Work is to be scheduled by Road Foreman.

New Business

Supervisor Wagner will contact resident Dave Flick regarding the ditch that was dug across his driveway.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Gordner, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:28pm.
