The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Wagner called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, and Hock; and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for May, 2011 meeting. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Hock. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Reports were reviewed. Additional invoices for approval: Lungers Machine Shop, sharpen mower blades \$90; Deb's Cleaning Service, thorough cleaning Community Center \$150. Supervisor Hock made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman

-68 approximate hours road maintenance including pipe replacement on Peacock Corners Road; cold patch, mowing, clean up tress and limbs.
-17 hours shop and truck maintenance.
-3 hours office work.

Met with engineers at Mordansville about our bridge. Met with Larson Design regarding AT&T cell tower and repairs to bridge. Supervisor Fenstermacher had numerous calls regarding the rough conditions where the pipe was replaced on Peacock Corners Road. Problem was due to very wet conditions and the need for a tamper. Resident Winn stated he has one for sale. Base repairs to be done on Peacock Corners Road soon.

Zoning Officer

No report.

Community Center

Large limb fell on the power lines and parking lot light during recent storm. Some damage to the siding and power lines attached to the building as well. Insurance adjuster inspected damage.

Secretary

-Participated in a webinar on May 17 regarding outdoor furnaces. One suggestion by the association conducting the program was to require a permit for all new and existing outdoor furnaces. DEP will have a model ordinance available soon, and strongly encourages Townships to adopt it at the local level.
-Participated in a teleconference on May 25 at 6pm. Topic was All-Hazard Mitigation Plan. All Townships must attend two meetings or risk not receiving financial aid following a disaster. Secretary will be attending last meeting on June 16 at 6pm at the Bloomsburg Fire Hall.

Correspondence

Supervisor Wagner received a thank you from Kocher Park for clean-up day. He received a letter from the Tri County COG stating they will be building a new building and have the finances to do so without asking for donations. A third correspondence came from resident Dean Robbins asking for a check to Ikeler Church for the grass plowed back by the Township plow. Supervisor Wagner inspected area and stated the damage was minor and was on the Township right of way. Mr. Robbins repaired the damage prior to sending the letter.

Old Business

Bridge at Lightstreet will be closed on 6/16. Supervisor Hock said he was informed that the work scheduled for Back Branch will not be done until the road washes out.

New Business

Motion by Supervisor Wagner to hire Dale Everett to mow berms, seconded by Supervisor Hock. Motion carried. Everett will be a part time employee covered by Township Workers Compensation.

For the Township Good

-Resident Winn complained about the condition of parts of Ikeler Hill Road. Tar and Chip will be done in July.

-Mordansville Road pipes need to be replaced.

-Supervisor Fenstermacher stated \$100,000 spent each year on roads.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Fenstermacher, seconded by Supervisor Hock to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:30pm.
