The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Wagner called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, and Hock; and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for August 2011 meeting. Supervisor Hock made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Reports were reviewed. Millville Fire Company pumped Community Center basement during storm. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to make an additional donation of \$250, seconded by Supervisor Hock. Motion carried. Supervisor Hock made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

Road Foreman

Sokol finished base repair on Peacock & McWilliams Roads. GM Crawford replaced pipe on Robbins Road. The three Supervisors have eighty five hours of flood repair between 9/7 and 9/12. Work to be completed: Rip rap and fix clay spot on Lick Run; Rip rap pipes on Rhodomoyer, Rote, McWilliams, Fox Hollow, Tomas, etc.

Center is designated Township emergency shelter. Supervisors will check into new generator that automatically senses power outage; installation of two smaller water heaters; price on new computer.

Old Business

Ordinances for Outdoor Burning; Small Wind Farms & Large Scale Commercial Wind Farms approved by Planning Commission and passed on to Supervisors. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to advertise, seconded by Supervisor Hock. Motion carried. Supervisor Fenstermacher questioned status of Fireworks Ordinance which was tabled at prior Planning meeting. Supervisor Wagner questioned if the Zoning Ordinances could be kept in a binder for ease of additions/corrections.

New Business

Pipe washed out at Rhodomoyer Road. Resident Whitenight offered \$8 a hundred for used pipe. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to sell, seconded by Supervisor Hock. Motion carried.
