Minutes of April 8, 2013

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, Gordner and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for March 2013 meeting. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Wagner. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Supervisor Wagner made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman

-91 man hours plowing snow, salting and cindering. Pipe replaced on Robbins Road; ditch cleaned on Ellis Turner; 3700 pounds of cold patch placed on Robbins, Rote Hollow, Welliversville and Thomas Roads

-20 hours on maintenance of equipment.

-4 hours office work.

-Estimated costs of \$184,455 will be put out for bid by the COG. \$17,624 to prime and seal Evert Road; \$41,250 to finish west side of Mordansville Road; \$74,580 for base repair on Peacock Corners Road; \$51,000 to fiber seal coat Peacock Corners Road.

Zoning Officer;

Not in attendance.

Community Center ;

Quote to replace both doors \$9000. Doors will not be replaced at this time. Glass was replaced on side door and lock was fixed at the handicap entrance.

Secretary ;

-PEMA must find additional funds before Township will proceed with acquiring and demolishing Hoffa property. The Township was informed that approximately \$99,000 would be available. That would buyout the property with no funds remaining for demolition, legal fees, etc.

Correspondence ;

-2012 Liquid Fuels report was approved by State.

-\$16,421.63 received by Township to be held in escrow on the Mainzer property which burned earlier this year.

Old Business

\$250 donation received from American Legion Post 273. Supervisor Wagner stated Township will receive \$500 from VFW.

New Business

-Supervisors discussed moving mailbox from McWilliams Road to Millertown Road. Mailman will contact Secretary.

-Supervisor Fenstermacher asked about plans for upgrading or replacing the shed. Supervisor Wagner will check into costs.

-Resident Stout wished to buy a piece of land on the corner of McWilliams and Peacock Corners Road from the Township in order to build a garage. Supervisors will need to check the legality according to the Township Codes.

For the Township Good

-Columbia County Conservation District has asked the Township to sign a letter of support. They want to apply for a grant to acquire a piece of the Johnson property to enlarge Kocher Park. Supervisors approved.

-Resident McWilliams hit a sign post on Shaner Road. He has asked the Township to submit a claim to our carrier. Supervisor Wagner will discuss with Thrush Insurance Agency.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Gordner, seconded by Supervisor Wagner to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:23pm.
