

Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of April 7, 2014

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Robbins, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for March 2014 meeting. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Supervisor Robbins made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman

-Plowing and cindering. Loader brakes repaired. Fill pot holes. Put belt spreader on. Remove downed tree on Fox Hollow. Williams, the firm representing the gas pipeline company, contacted the Township to determine Township policy when a pipeline crosses a Township road. Supervisor Fenstermacher stated the roads should be returned to their original condition. Supervisor Gordner reported a mobile home is being placed on the hill across from the Wanich Covered Bridge. Sokol is the contractor and indicated he will need to place fill on the Township road to get the unit up the hill. Sokol will remove fill and fix driveway to divert water to nearby pipe. Pipe and ditch are filled with dirt from runoff on Martenas Road.

OLD BUSINESS:

None to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS:

-Supervisor Gordner made motion to adopt Resolution 83-14 designating the Secretary as the agent for PEMA paperwork, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried. Former Supervisor Wagner had been the main contact with Kindt as alternate.

-Supervisors were approached by the Orangeville Library for a donation. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to donate \$250 seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

-Supervisor Gordner found a road drag for \$1,550 in West Beaver Township. After some discussion, Supervisor Gordner made motion to purchase, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. There was discussion of selling the grader to buy another large truck. Supervisor Fenstermacher felt a better use for the money would be to improve the roads.

-Resident Black reported that the GPS system is being used for purposes that were not intended. Therefore, there is no way to direct large trucks/ambulances, etc. around roads that are not designed for larger vehicles.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:

- Resident Kressler commended the road crew for snow removal efforts.
- Resident Hock questioned if Township might buy a backhoe. Supervisors felt Dave Robbins was doing a satisfactory job which saved the Township maintenance on equipment.
- Supervisor Gordner stated he will contract out the Martenas Road project.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Fenstermacher, seconded by Supervisor Gordner to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:325pm.
