

## **Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of August 5, 2013**

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

### MINUTES

- \$180.12 received from Act 13, Marcellus Well Drilling fee distribution.
- Resolution 77-13 – First Keystone Online Banking Resolution. Supervisor Wagner made motion to adopt, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.
- Four bids were received for the Rote Hollow Road DSA project. They were as follows: Pike's Creek/Reading Materials - \$15,625; Robert C. Young, Inc – \$14,806.25; Eastern Industries, Inc – \$17,437.50; HRI, Inc – \$16,250. The bid was awarded to R.C. Young as the lowest bidder.
- Resident Klesh asked if something could be done about washouts in front of mailboxes on Thomas Road. Supervisor Wagner will inspect. He will also check berm washouts on English Hill Road.
- Resident Kennedy questioned what permits he needed to replace a porch. He was given information to contact Zoning Officer Sanders, as well as the Tri County COG inspection office.
- Several more complaints from residents regarding the target shooting on Robbins property.
