The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, Gordner and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for January 2013 meeting. Supervisor Wagner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

Road Foreman

Community Center ;

Hole in wall under cabinet needs to be repaired.

Secretary :

Workers Compensation and DCED audits scheduled for February. Meeting with PEMA officials February 5, 2013 to discuss Parks elevation.

Correspondence ;

- Orangeville Baseball Association requested permission to use Community Center fields this summer. Supervisor Gordner made motion to allow, seconded by Supervisor Wagner. Motion carried.
- Appointed solicitor Hummel requested a \$300 retainer for 2013. Supervisor Wagner made motion to pay, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

Old Business

- The Martenas and Johnson subdivision plans were discussed. Plans meet Township criteria. Supervisor Wagner made motion, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.
- After a program presented at PPL, a firm conducted a study of the lighting at shed and Community Center. The cost would be approximately \$9100 to replace current lighting with high efficiency fixtures. Would take Township approximately seven years to recoup cost, with no guarantees. Supervisor Gordner made motion to table the issue, seconded by Supervisor Wagner. Motion carried.
