

## Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of July 1, 2013

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, Gordner, Zoning Officer Sanders and Secretary Kindt.

Jeremiah Adams, one of the boys involved in the February break-in at the Community Center offered an apology for his actions.

### MINUTES

Minutes were presented for June 2013 meeting. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Wagner. Motion carried.

### FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Supervisor Wagner made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

### REPORTS

#### Road Foreman

- 155 hours on road work including mowing, grading, replacing cross pipes on Peacock Corners Road, and cleanup of several downed trees.
- Base repair completed on Rhodomoyer Road along with cross pipes paved on Robbins Road.
- 2 hours on maintenance of equipment.
- 3 hours office work.

#### Zoning Officer:

During the months of January thru July, I've issued 13 permits. One (1) mobile home, one (1) home, a winery through special exception, a pool, six (6) accessory structures, and three (3) additions. I addressed several complaints, mostly neighbor disputes. One was for a right-away and the other was an animal complaint. As always, I continue to perform inspections, field monitoring and follow-up on inquiries and complaints.

- Resident Chris Donahue complained about noise from target shooting involving exploding targets. There have been several similar complaints to the Township. Zoning Officer Sanders inquired if they had a shooting range. They stated they did not.
- Resident Wayne Swank complained about the condition of English Hill Road. Road Foreman Wagner stated there are no dollars to repair English Hill this year.
