The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Robbins, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

### MINUTES

Minutes were reviewed for the June meeting. Supervisor Robbins made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

### FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Supervisor Robbins made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

### REPORTS

#### Road Foreman

-Road foreman off several days for illness. Majority of road work done this month included patching holes and mowing.

#### Correspondence:

- Letter received from DCNR regarding final inspection of Community Center grounds which was precipitated by grant received several years ago. ADA issues will need to be addressed if further grants are received.
- Received formal approval of 2012 Liquid Fuels audit.

#### Old Business:

Supervisor Fenstermacher has not discussed 1190 Millville Road with Mr. Zenzel regarding use as a parking area for fishing, etc.

#### New Business:

- Resolution 84-14 to acknowledge receipt of Gas Well Impact fees and determine how the \$178.27 will be spent.
- After second advertising, only one bid again received for road work from Hammaker. After review, it was decided to accept the entire contracts as written. Bit Seal total \$180,746.12; Cold Mix Pave \$63,763.20. Supervisor Gordner made motion, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.
- Supervisor Gordner questioned what the procedure was for hiring part time help. Job will be advertised, applications will be accepted, interviews will be conducted before someone is hired. Job description will state part time, flexible hours, emergency availability required. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to follow these procedures, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.
- Supervisor Gordner questioned if it was State law that Township employees involved in mowing berms be followed by a second vehicle with flashing lights. Check with PennDOT.

Public Participation: No comments received.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Fenstermacher, seconded by Supervisor Gordner to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:46pm.
