

Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of May 6, 2013

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, Gordner and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for April 2013 meeting. Supervisor Wagner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Wagner. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman

- 89 hours on road work including removing three trees, mowing, cleaning ditches, grading roads.
- 21 hours on maintenance of equipment.
- 4 hours office work.
- Bid through COG for Mordansville and Peacock Corners Road approximately \$155,000.

Community Center :

- Quotes received for security system in Community Center: Vector - \$3889.00, ADT - \$3178.00, and Bower Security - \$3585.00. Bower supplies only cameras. Vector and ADT supply cameras and motion detectors. Supervisor Wagner will contact Northeastern Technology for a quote. Decision was tabled until next meeting.
- A group wishing to form a new church asked to rent the Center on Sundays. The request was denied because the Center is often rented to residents for various functions on the weekends.

Old Business

- Township received \$500 donation from VFW.
- The Supervisors considered moving the mailbox from McWilliams Road to Millertown Road near the Community Center. Postman will not come in the driveway to deliver. It was decided to replace the mailbox with a lockbox on a new post and let it remain on McWilliams Road.

New Business

- Hemsarth subdivision was reviewed. He will transfer approximately 1.5 acres on the opposite side of the creek to landowner Kehoe. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Wagner. Motion carried.
- Resident Stout on Peacock Corners Road wishes to purchase a piece of land on the corner of McWilliams and Peacock Corners Road. This parcel is Township property. Resident must present plans. Land must be advertised before it can be sold. A decision was tabled until more information is available.

-Resident Force presented pictures of Johnson Road showing blocked pipes which are causing damage to several residents driveways. Supervisor Wagner stated that Johnson Road is on the project list. It will be done in about two weeks.

Public Participation

Tractor Show will be July 20. Crafters will utilize the inside of the Center as well as outside. Shultz will be supplying food for sale.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Gordner, seconded by Supervisor Wagner to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:30pm.
