## SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES FROM APRIL 10, 2017

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman McWilliams. Those present were: McWilliams, Gordner, B. Robbins, W. Westover and public attendance eight (8).

Pledge of Allegiance

Minutes: Motion by Gordner to approve March minutes, second by B. Robbins, All in favor.

Treasurers Report: Motion by B. Robbins to approve the Treasurer's report, second by Gordner, All in favor.

Township Reports: Road Foreman-Patch potholes, open ditches/Tiger ditcher, winter storm Stella-Hired 1 small truck to assist Township plows, had extra loader to open drifts, hired 2 backhoes to open ditches, all bus routes ready by Wednesday, but schools closed for the week, since other townships not ready.

Secretary/Correspondence-Donation request for John Buck Memorial Community Food Bank- located in Orange Twp/no previous donation. Motion by B. Robbins to donate \$500, second by Gordner, All in favor.

Old Business: April 10-14 Stream Bank Restoration at Ellis Turner Culvert-will done early Tuesday.  
Thomas Road trees-No decision from Bloomsburg Archery Club, Township pursued having Township right of way done. Should serve as wake up call for all regarding problem/hazardous trees re: 2 on Kindt Road.

New Business: Adoption of the Hazard Mitigation Plan Resolution 2017-2. (Review full plan at <http://ema.columbiapa.org/public/hm/FINALCCHMPU2017WOAPPEN.pdf>) Motion by B. Robbins, second by Gordner, All in favor.

Winter Storm Stella-No one receiving reimbursement in the State.

CPA-Advertising for 30 days, voting on at May meeting. Concern noted of being able to hire CPA at limit of \$1000 per the Township Code. Research will be done.

For the Good (Public Participation):

Compliments during storm, but concerns about previous storms and culvert on Thomas Road. Concerns about Robbins farm being paid during storm, since he's supervisor and the other emergency hires. Robbins mentioned Attorney noted Emergency Situation and 2 trucks down and needed a tow truck to be able to get to stuck plow truck. But concern that Township did not declare emergency, will look into. Check with insurance about towing reimbursement. Hemlock Fire Company Workers compensation bill? Yes township responsible for their part with all 4 fire departments, if they remember to bill Townships. They should look at provider due to high cost. Concern over Governor wanting to charge \$25 per resident for State Police coverage.
