

**MT PLEASANT TOWNSHIP  
MINUTES FROM DECEMBER 5, 2016**

- Meeting was called to order by Chairman McWilliams. Those present were, McWilliams, Gornder, B. Robbins and Secretary M. Robbins.

- Minutes: A motion was made by Gordner to approve the November minutes, seconded by B. Robbins. All in favor, carried.

- Township Report: Supervisor Gordner reported that they removed trees and cleaned out ditches. He stated that the Culvert was installed on Ellis Turner Rd. and although a little bit more work remains but will have to wait until spring as the Fish Commission has to come and check out the stream. Supervisor Gordner brought up the subject that he feels that the rent on the Community Center is too low compared to other place in surrounding area.
