

Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of January 10, 2011

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the special meeting on the above date to discuss Township issues and appoint a replacement for Supervisor Shaffer. Chairman Wagner called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher; Wagner; and Secretary Kindt.

- (1) Appointment of a tax collector for Mount Pleasant Township. Supervisor Wagner made motion to appoint Columbia County, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.
- (2) Appoint resident Terry Hess as an alternate to the Zoning Hearing Board. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to appoint, seconded by Supervisor Wagner. Motion carried.
- (3) Approve payment of the following invoices: Orange Twp, recycling \$179.86; Press Enterprise, newspaper notices \$46.41; Renco, 2 snow broom extenders \$23.98; PA League of Cities, dues \$65.00; Ed Sanders, mileage \$15.00; AmeriHealth Casualty, workers comp \$3802.00; Bloomsburg Public Library, donation in Roy Shaffer's memory \$100. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Wagner. Motion carried.
- (4) Four residents submitted a letter of interest for the open position of Supervisor through the remainder of 2011: Doug Hock; John Gordner; Dave Edgar, George McWilliams. Supervisor Wagner made motion to appoint Doug Hock, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried. The position will be on the May primary ballot, and residents interested are urged to file.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Wagner, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:05pm.
